**Candle Guide**

# Steps to follow to make you a candle pro

The first time is always memorable...

Yep, you need to let the candle burn until the top layer of wax has fully melted. If you don't, you will be left with a memory ring, which means the candle will continue to burn in that shape for the rest of it's life (you don't want this to happen)

Don't blow it

There's a risk to blowing out hot wax and the smoke can take over the scent that you've just put into the room. Instead, try using a candle snuff or you can dip the wick into wax but remember to straighten it up afterwards (be careful when doing this and don't use your hands)

Get a trim

We all like to keep things tidy, so keep the wick at 3cm for the best results

Burn baby burn

You've got to use your candle for the right amount of time. Blow it out too quickly and you can end up with a memory ring but burn it too long and your candle will start smoking. A good rule is to not burn your candle for more than 4 hours.

Don't be draft

Keep your candle away from any moving air, you don't want any accidents

Okay, it's time to stop

Even though there might be some wax still in the bottom, if the wick has completed it's burn then it's telling you that it's over. DW, you can scoop out the leftover wax, wash it and reuse it. Trust us, they make epic pen holders

## The legal stuff that we have to tell you...

Failure to follow instructions could result in fire, hazard, or injury.

Keep candles out of the reach of children & pets. Do not place lit candles where they can be knocked over by children, pets or anyone else.

Never touch or move a burning candle. Never move a candle container when the wax is liquified.

If burning multiple candles, place each candle at least three inches apart from one another. This is to ensure they don't melt one another, or create their own drafts.

Never burn a candle on or near anything that can catch fire. Keep burning candles away from furniture, drapes, bedding, carpets, books, paper, flammable decorations etc. If using a pillar candle, it should be stored and burnt on a large plate or dish so that any excess wax that drips down does not ruin or spoil any table top surfaces.

Trim wick to 0.6cm before lighting.

Wipe clean with a damp cloth only.

Burn on a heat resistant surface only.
